



LEGAL INFORMATION #CORONAVIRUS ON RESIDENCE PERMITS AND APPEALS

If you have applied for a residence permit for the first time or if you need to renew your permit, you can only go to the Police headquarters after April 15. Instead, residence permits expiring from January 31, 2020 to April 15, 2020, not yet renewed, are valid until June 15.

Tickets and identity cards that already expired or are about to expire are valid until 31 August.

If you had a negative answer from the board or the court but have not yet appealed, everything stops until April 15. Find a lawyer now.

If you have an expulsion or confirmation of detention at cpr, with these rules there is no suspension.

If you have to make an initial request for asylum or to repeat one, you can go to the police headquarters in the city where you live. If the Police Headquarters refuses, you can go to the court that admits your case in these cases (precautionary or emergency procedure ex art. 700 cpc) with the help of a lawyer.

If you need to apply for a registration, you can do it online with an email. Send the form, and also in this case for refusal or no response you can sue the Court (precautionary or urgent procedure ex art. 700 cpc) with the help of a lawyer.

All deadlines for appealing to the Administrative Court the rejections of permits for work are suspended until 15/4/2020, you can ask the judge to suspend the contested measures.
